Your duties and responsibilities:

- Collate, analyse and consolidate data
- Prepare and update internal evaluation reports using Tableau
- Provide feedback and recommendations based on data analysis and evidence to the country offices and the Managing Director Programmes
- Create and update impact reports for marketing purposes using Tableau
- Research and development for monitoring and evaluation tools and reports (surveys, checklists, statistics etc.)
- Ensure data quality through data quality control and clean up
- Provide general remote support to the monitoring and evaluation activities of the country offices
- Strengthen capacity of employees and partners in monitoring and evaluation

- a Bachelor's degree in international relations, international development, statistics, or equivalent education
- at least 5 years of work experience in the field of monitoring and evaluation in an NGO or similar environment
